Dominion creates construction yard for pipeline



A staging area for construction of Dominion Energy's 42-inch gas pipeline has been established at Green Bank, W.Va. The site contains dozens of dozers, excavators, and other pieces of heavy equipment, along with several buses. The equipment will be used to excavate a 125-foot wide, clear-cut right of way through private and public lands, including national forests. A 10-foot deep trench will be dug along the 600-mile pipeline corridor, crossing hundreds of creeks and rivers. The equipment at Green Bank belongs to Houston-based U.S. Pipeline Inc., one of four pipeline companies engaged in joint venture Spring Ridge Constructors LLC. Dominion awarded a contract to Spring Ridge in September 2016 for pipeline construction from Harrison County, W.Va., to Robeson County, N.C., with a spur line to the Hampton Roads area.
